COMBINGING PIECING AND APPLIQUE

ANNA MARIA HORNER



Combining patchwork and applique can make dynamic and appealing quilts.

- Clear thread and tiny blind stitches can hide machine applique or you can hand applique.
- You can add additional piecing in your background fabric to create visual interest.
- Machine baste your larger applique pieces onto your background for stability before applying the bias strip applique.
- For areas that are covered by large applique, cut out the background on the backside of the fabric. You can incorporate these into other areas of the auilt.
- Using a fabric smoother, like Flatter, can help keep your bias pieces flat.
- Iron your bias pieces on to your top to get them very smooth.
- Use decorative stitches to machine applique for added interest and strength.
