

DIGITALLY PRINTED FABRIC

There are a number of websites where you can digitally print fabric. Here are some tips:

- Edit the photo size and crop the image as much as possible before uploading it to Spoonflower.
- Image size, along with the width of your selected fabric, will dictate the number of repeats.
- For more information I suggest looking at a dvd workshop by Jane Dunnewold called "Design and Print Your Own Fabric", and the Spoonflower Handbook, which is a project-driven guidebook.
- PicMonkey is a software program that can be accessed through the Spoonflower website and is a simple way to alter color and detail on your image.
