WALKING FOOT SPIRAL CHRISTINA CAMELI



- Use your walking foot and freezer paper to make a simple quilted spiral!
- Start by tracing a circle onto freezer paper. Make sure the circle is at least 3-4" wide. Cut out the circle.
- Iron the freezer paper shiny side down to the spot where you want the spiral's center to be.
- Begin quilting by stitching right along the side of the freezer paper until you have come around the whole circle. Use a twisting motion of the hands to rotate the piece under the machine as you work.
- After completing the stitched circle, slowly come away from the circle bit by bit until the stitched circle is aligned with the side of your walking foot. You can remove the freezer paper circle now if you wish.
- Now continue stitching, keeping the stitched curve following along the side of the walking foot. This will keep your spacing consistent as you go.
- As you work outward it will get easier to turn your quilt and your line of stitching will be smoother.
