TIPS

- You can download the snail pattern demonstrated from Violet's website here: violetcraft.com/pdf/forest-abstractions-quiltthe-snail
- Always make a copy of the pattern, so you can remake your pattern
- If printing a pattern from a pdf, always be sure your printer settings are "actual size" and at the percentage indicated on the pattern
- The pattern is the reverse image of the final piece
- Use paper piecing thread, a straight stitch and smaller stitch length
- Precut your seams as instructed in the segment
- Always sew a at least a quarter inch past the lines on your pattern
- Use a seam roller to flatten your seams instead of ironing
- When tearing away the paper, start from the outside and work in
- Violet recommends the following tools to make paper piecing easy:
 - Quilting ruler or add-a-quarter ruler
 - Seam Roller: violetcraft.com/pdf/violet-craft-seam-roller
