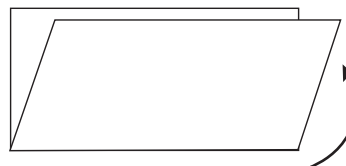


PAPER AND FABRIC FOLDING:

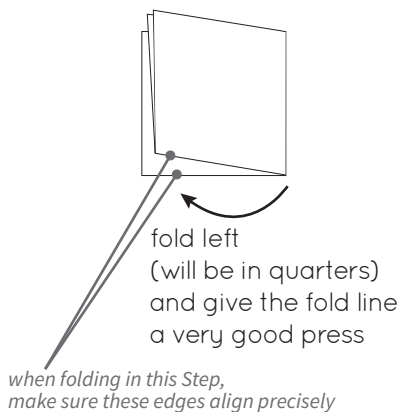

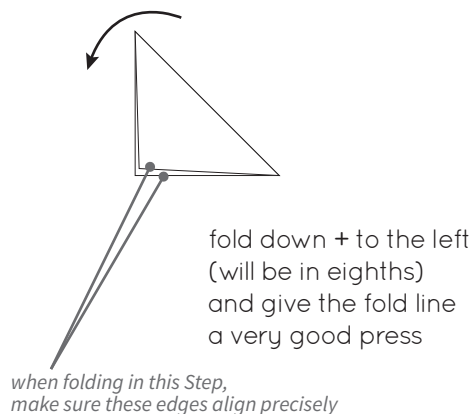


fold up (will be in half)

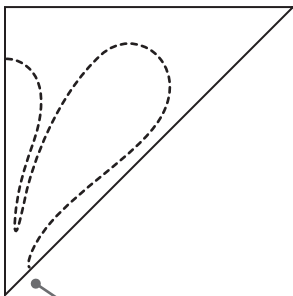


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TRANSFER DESIGN FROM PAPER TO FABRIC:



when matching folded paper template to folded fabric, align single fold edges of both paper and fabric

PLAY WITH COLOR, NEGATIVE SPACE AND BACKGROUNDS

Make the same block look different by:

- experimenting with color — both with the applique motif and the background
- designing and piecing different backgrounds
- making multiple blocks and piecing them together
