ENGLISH PAPER PIECING VIOLET CRAFT



TIPS

- You can purchase the Lion pattern demonstrated from Violet's website here: violetcraft.com/pdf/the-lion-an-epp-project
- Use a tape roller to hold paper in place while rough cutting fabric. Cut a bit larger than 1/4" so that it can withstand handling.
- Use a water soluable glue stick to speed up basting.
- Use a clip to hold your pieces in place while sewing
- Violet prefers a #10 milliners needle.
- Violet prefers a 100 weight polyester thread.
- Keep stitches about 1/16" inch apart.
- Bend your templates to stitch odd angles. For the odd angles, work from the outside in on your stiches so the points come together.
- When tearing away the paper, start from the inside out
- Using organizers to keep your templates, fabrics, thread and needles ready.
