

PAPER PIECING WITH AUDREY ESAREY

- Use paper as a foundation to get crisp and exact seams.
 - Reduce stitch length to 1.5 in order to perforate the paper foundation as you sew.
 - Mark the back side of your paper templates with the correct colors to prevent mix-ups.
 - As you paper piece, sew with the fabric on the bottom and the paper template facing up.
 - Sew on the solid line on your template paper, and backstitch at each end.
 - Use a finger presser and ruler to trim as you go!
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- “Indigo Radial” quilt pattern
